### **SANITARY SEWER AND PUMPING STATION REHABILITATION PROJECT (EAST MAIN STREET PUMP STATION) FAIRFIELD MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY FAIRFIELD BOROUGH, ADAMS COUNTY, PA**

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Fairfield Municipal Authority's proposed Sanitary Sewer and Pumping Station Rehabilitation Project (East Main Street Pump Station) will be received at the office of the Authority at 108 West Main Street, Fairfield, PA 17320, until 7:00pm local time on Tuesday June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The Project includes installation of a new pump station wet well, elevated platform, and the associated appurtenances and restoration.

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is Keller Engineers, Inc., 420 Allegheny Street, Hollidaysburg, PA 16648. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm and must obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents are available digitally by contacting the above Issuing Office at (814) 696-7430. Printed copies of the Bidding Documents may also be obtained, during the hours indicated above, upon payment of a deposit of \$50.<sup>00</sup>. Bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 10 days after receipt of Bids will receive a full refund. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to "Keller Engineers, Inc.". Upon request and receipt of the document deposit indicated above plus a non-refundable shipping charge, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents via delivery service. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.
