INVITATION TO BID
COUNTY ROAD 104 (CRANBERRY ROAD) REHABILITATION
NORTH WOODBURY TOWNSHIP, BLAIR COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Sealed bids will be received by the County of Blair for the County Road 104 (Cranberry Road) Rehabilitation Project. Bids will be received and opened at the Blair County Controllers Office, 423 Allegheny Street, Suite 141, Hollidaysburg, Pennsylvania 16648 until 2:00 p.m. local prevailing time July 10, 2026. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. Bids will be accepted for review at the Blair County Board of Commissioners meeting on July 16, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. and awarded in accordance with the County Code thereafter. Bidders must submit an original of the Bid in a sealed envelope clearly marked "Bid Proposal for County Road 104 (Cranberry Road) Rehabilitation Project" with bidder's name and address. ELECTRONIC SUBMISSIONS ARE NOT PERMITTED. Any omissions, alterations, additions or deductions not called for, conditional or uninvited alternative bids, or irregularities of any kind, shall be cause for rejection of bid. No responsibility shall be attached to any County representative for premature opening of a bid not properly addressed and identified.

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is Keller Engineers, Inc., 420 Allegheny Street, Hollidaysburg, PA 16648. Electronic copies of the Bidding Documents must be obtained from the Issuing Office. Bidding Documents are available in portable document file (PDF) format and will be emailed to the prospective bidder. To schedule an appointment at Keller Engineers, Inc. to review the Bidding Documents or obtain a copy, call (814) 696-7430. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. All bidders must be registered at the office of Keller Engineers, Inc. to be eligible to bid.

Pre-Qualification of Bidder as Specified in Section 102.01 of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) Specifications Publication 408 is required.

Bid Security shall be made payable to the County of Blair in the amount of ten (10) percent of the bid price and in the form of certified or bank check or an unaltered bid bond in the form provided in the Project Manual issued by an acceptable surety and executed by the bidder. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the date set for the opening of the bids. Bid Security will be returned to unsuccessful bidders. The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for satisfactory performance and payment bonds in the form provided in the Bid Documents (unaltered), each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the contract, within fifteen (15) days of the date of the written Notice of Award of the contract. Failure to furnish bonds and proof of insurance as required by the bidding documents within this time period as well as provide subcontractor and/or supplier information per Article 12 of Section 100 shall, at the option of the County, constitute grounds to revoke the bid award and declare the bid security forfeited.

The Blair County Commissioners reserve the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality, omissions, defects or irregularities in the bids, and to accept and award any contract which, in its judgment, is for the best interest of the Blair County Commissioners. The County of Blair may consider the qualifications and experience of the bidders and proposed subcontractors when evaluating bids. If the Contract is to be awarded, it will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder whose evaluation by the County of Blair indicates to the County of Blair that the award will be in the best interest of the project.
