

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE
EVERETT BOROUGH, BEDFORD COUNTY, PA**

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Borough of Everett Area Municipal Authority's (BEAMA) proposed Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade project will be received at the office of BEAMA at 100 Mechanic Street, Everett, PA 15537, until 1:00 pm local time on Tuesday September 1st, 2026, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Work covers the installation and construction of a new influent pump station, a new sequencing batch reactor treatment plant, control and process buildings, and the associated site improvements. Work will also include demolition and conversion of portions of the existing treatment plant, along with all related equipment, appurtenances and restoration.

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is Keller Engineers, Inc., 420 Allegheny Street, Hollidaysburg, PA 16648. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm and must obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents are available digitally by contacting the above Issuing Office at (814) 696-7430.

Printed copies of the Bidding Documents may also be obtained, during the hours indicated above, upon payment of a deposit of \$200.⁰⁰. Bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 10 days after receipt of Bids will receive a full refund. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to "Keller Engineers, Inc.". Upon request and receipt of the document deposit indicated above plus a non-refundable shipping charge, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents via delivery service. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office.

Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 am local time on Tuesday August 11th, 2026, starting at the Authority office at the above address and continuing thereafter at the existing treatment plant. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

Bid security of 10% of the bid price shall be furnished in accordance with the Information for Bidders. This project is being funded by the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority (PENNVEST). Davis-Bacon wage rates, American Iron and Steel provisions, and additional State/Federal requirements will apply to all work.
