

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

TRAFFIC CIRCLE IMPROVEMENTS BURNHAM BOROUGH, MIFFLIN COUNTY, PA

Sealed Bids for the construction of Burnham Borough's proposed Traffic Circle Improvements project will be received at the office of Burnham Borough at 200 1st Avenue, Burnham, PA 17009, until 12:00 pm local time on September 8, 2026. The Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Borough Council meeting that same evening at 7:00 pm.

Two prime contracts will be offered – General (Contract 1) and Electrical (Contract 2). Contract 1 includes but is not limited to demolition, concrete curbing, concrete sidewalks, bollard installation, and seeding and mulching. Contract 2 includes lighting demolition, and new lighting installation with wiring.

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is Keller Engineers, Inc., 420 Allegheny Street, Hollidaysburg, PA 16648. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm and must obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bid Documents are available as pdf files on a thumb drive for a non-refundable charge of \$25, including shipping. Printed copies of the Bidding Documents must be obtained from the Issuing Office, upon payment of a deposit of \$50.00. Bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 10 days after receipt of Bids will receive a full refund. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to "Keller Engineers, Inc.". Upon request and receipt of the document deposit indicated above plus a non-refundable shipping charge, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents via delivery service. The shipping charge amount will depend on the shipping method selected by the prospective Bidder. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Information for Bidders. Pennsylvania State Prevailing Wage rates, along with additional State requirements, will apply to all work.

The Borough of Burnham reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any and all informalities.
